Lope de Vega is the lone area in EV in the list

Comelec places N. Samar town as election hot spot

TACLOBAN CITY- The Commission on Elections (Comelec) has placed the entire town of Lope de Vega in Northern Samar under its watch list area relative to the conduct of the May 13 elections.

Lawyer Felicisimo Embalsado, Comelec assistant regional director, said that the town was placed under its category 'red' hot spot.

The Comelec places an area under its category red hot spot if an area has a history of political violence and with strong presence of armed and rebel groups.

The poll body uses color in identifying areas of concern relative to the May 13 elections with color red as

the most 'critical.'

"The red color is the highest one," Embalsado said.

Lope de Vega is the only area in the region which was placed under the red category joining the entire Mindanao Island and Abra province.

Embalsado said that with the placing of Lope de Vega under the red category, the poll body together with the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and

the Philippine National Police (PNP) will give their focus to the said area.

This way, conduct of the elections at Lope de Vega would not be hampered with the voters exercising fully their rights of suffrage or whom they want to become their leaders, he added.

Embalsado added that the possibility of providing additional presence of soldiers or police to Lope de Vega is being considered. *see Comelec/page 9 ...*



Senator Villar, Pimentel back President Duterte's decision PH withdrawal from ICC

TACLOBAN CITY- Two administration senators backed on the decision of President Rodrigo Duterte to withdraw from the International Criminal Court (ICC).

And both Senators Cynthia Villar and Koko Pimentel believes that there would be no fallout with the Philippines' withdrawal from the said international tribunal.

According to Villar, investors are not really concern whether the country is still part of the ICC but more on its economic fundamentals.

"Alam mo yung mga investors, tinitingnan nila ang GDP growth; kung tayo ay may recession. Kasi kapag may recession tayo, matatakot sila. Pagbumaba ang GDP growth, matatakot sila hindi yung (withdrawal from) ICC," Villar said on Tuesday (March 19).

Sen. Villar added that there is nothing to worry on this move of the President saying that all the

courts in the country remain functional where complaints that may involve government instrumentalities or officials could be lodged.

For Sen. Pimentel, there should not be an issue on the decision of Pres. Duterte to withdraw from ICC considering that even the world's super powers like the United States is not part of the ICC.

"Let it be. The President has decided to withdraw. Let's honor his decision," he said.

"Sa tingin ko wala naman epekto sa atin yan. Ang malalaki at progresibong mg bansa gaya ng United States, India, Russia and China hindi naman ICC members," Pimentel said.

He also said that the move to withdraw from the ICC does not need any Senate concurrence.

"Ang Senate, approval sa pag-sali pero sa pagkalas, nandon na mismo yung proseso sa treaty," Pimentel said.

For Governor Imee

Marcos, another ally of the administration who is running for senator under the Hugpong ng Pagbabago, she feel it was just right for the President to withdraw from the ICC.

"Sabi ni Presidente, we are a sovereign nation. Dapat walang makikialam sa atin. I think, we are within our rights to do that," Marcos said.

She also said that investors will continue to come to the country as the Philippines is now considered as among the world's prime investment destinations.

"We are doing well economically. Ang taas-taas ng growth rate natin so there is no reason why the investors will not come here," Marcos added.

Decreasing trend in measles cases in East Visayas seen, says DOH-8 official

PALO, Leyte- A top official of the Department of Health Regional Office 8 (DOH-8) on Monday reported a decreasing trend in measles cases in Eastern Visayas due to the intensified immunization activities.

In a press briefing at the DOH regional office here, Assistant Regional Director Exuperia Sabalberino said their immunization program already covered 50 percent of the 192,056 children population aged 6 to 59 months old, targeted for the outbreak immunization response.

"These are generally the children living in the poblacion areas, so we deployed volunteer-nurses to all the municipalities in the region to help the local government units in conducting the immunization especially those hard-to-reach barangays," Sabalberino said.

In the same briefing, Roderick Boyd Cerro, chief of the regional epi-

demiology and surveillance unit, reported 1,080 measles cases with 24 deaths in the region from January 1 to March 8 this year, compared to only eight cases with no death in the same period last year.

Cerro said the victims' age ranged from 21 days old to 82 years old, wherein more than half (52 percent) were children under 5 years old and 52.8 percent of the cases did not receive vaccines.

The health department is continuously monitoring the measles transmission on a weekly basis and has noticed a slow down on the number of cases starting last week of February.

"Morbidity week 8 has 240 measles cases, then it went down to 160 cases on week 9 (Feb. 24-Mar. 2) and 70 on week 10 (Mar. 3-9)," Cerro further reported.

Elaine Villaros, immunization program manager, said they also recommended during the health cluster inter-agency meeting, that

athletes who will be joining the Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Meet in Ormoc City on April 7-12, 2019, should be immunized at least two weeks prior to the event to prevent the spread of transmission of measles cases, considering also the big crowd.

"Ormoc City is also preparing for this and is conducting an intensive immunization for four weeks now, to protect also their community," Villaros said.

Meanwhile, the assistant regional director added that with the improved health-seeking behavior, more mothers bring their children to the health centers for vaccination, Sabalberino added.

"DOH is trying everything to control the transmission with the help of all our stakeholders, the media for the advocacy to help us out to reach these mothers especially in the hard-to-reach barangays," she said. (LDLopido/PIA-8, Leyte)

300 foreign tourists on board cruise ship visit Kalanggaman Island

PALOMPON, Leyte - For almost half a day, about 300 European tourists did nothing but enjoy the raw yet stunning beauty of the Kalanggaman Island, this town.

The foreign tourists, on board of MS Europa, a cruise ship owned and operated by a German company, Hapag-Lloyd, arrived at the famed island on Thursday (March 21) from their visit in Bohol.

"I'd been in this island for a couple of times. What we love in this place, aside from the beautiful white sand beach and the water, are the facilities that are basic needs of tourists like the toilets and dressing area," Sacha Ritcher, MS Europa said.

For 10 hours, tourists ate barbeque and stroll the island's sandbar, swim on its clear and clean water; do some snorkeling. Others simply had their sun bathing in the island.

And during their brief stay in Kalanggaman, they were entertained with folk dance performances like curacha and singkil by the students of the Palompon Institute of Technology and from the local government unit.

After Kalanggaman Island, MS Europa sailed to Boracay Island where they stayed for 10 hours before leaving for Hong Kong.

Tourism Regional Director Karina Rosa Tiopes said that they prefer small cruise ships like MS Europa 2 that also visited Kalanggaman last January.

"This type of cruise ship is the most appropriate type for our tourist destinations because we don't want our islands to be overwhelmed. They will only leave minimal footprint when they leave the island," she said.

Tiopes added that only two cruise ships had in-

formed their office of doing port call in the region, one was MS Europa 2 that also visited Kalanggaman last January.

"But this doesn't mean that there are only two cruise ships for this year, because there are instances that we receive surprise call from cruise operators in Manila that there is a cruise ship coming to Eastern Visayas," she added. (ROEL T. AMAZONA)

Commercial vessel sinks off Guiuan town; 30 crews safe

CAMP RUPERTO KAN- GLEON, PALO, Leyte- A commercial fishing vessel with 30 crew members on board sunk off the waters of Guiuan town, Eastern Samar on Monday (March 18) morning.

Reports reaching the regional headquarters of the Philippine National Police (PNP), disclosed that at about 10 pm of said date, the Saint Anthony commercial vessel was about to anchor in Barangay Sulangan when it hit some corals at the In-atraban Reef, about three nautical miles from Barangay Ngolos, also in Guiuan town.

The incident resulted to damage of the vessel's bow which resulted for it to sunk.

Members of the Guiuan Municipal Police Station led by Police Chief Inspector Jerome B. Camacho went to the area and help the personnel of the Saint Anthony commercial vessel, said to be owned by Erlinda Cailim of

Tacloban City.

All the 30 personnel were declared safe and unharm, report from the Guiuan Municipal Police Station under its chief of police, Chief Inspector Jerome Camacho. (PR)

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American lawyer to help alleged sex victims of a priest in Naval

TACLOBAN CITY- Alleged victims of sexual abuse by an American priests previously assigned in Naval town, Biliran province, may just get their justice through the help of an American lawyer.

On Tuesday (March 19), McDonald Worley, an American lawyer based in Houston, Texas, came to Naval to personally interview nine of the victims of Fr. Kenneth Bernard Pius Hendricks who stand accused of sexual molestation of ‘several’ young boys who mostly served as his altar boys.

Hendricks served as a missionary priest in Barangay Talustosan, Naval since 1988 and was arrested by members of the Homeland Security of the United States, together with the personnel of the Bureau of Immigration and Deportation, and local police on December 5, 2018 inside the St. Isidore the Worker Chapel in said village.

The 77-year old priest is currently detained at the Regional Special Operation Unit of the National Capital Region Police Office in Quezon City and stand accused for acts of lasciviousness and child abuse under Republic Act 7610, or the ‘Special Protection of Children against Abuse, Exploitation, and Discrimination Act.

Worley, in a press conference Wednesday

(March 20), said that he is not after the criminal liability of Hendricks but on civil aspect, particularly on seeking compensation to his young victims who are now on their early to late 20’s.

“I have nothing to do with the criminal aspect of the case. I just handle the civil side. So, it’s basically (collecting) money that has to be paid to the victims,” Worley said.

According to him, he is not getting any money as legal service fees from the victims though he expect to receive a percentage of what possible financial rewards that the jury would award to the case that he expects to last at least for three years.

The civil case will be filed by Worley in Cincinnati, Ohio where Hendricks came from.

Hendricks is also facing a federal crime as an American citizen for engaging in illicit sexual acts in a foreign country.

Worley said that he was able to get to know the ‘horrible’ stories of the victims through an American friend who lives in Manila who has a friend from Naval.

“I am sad that this happened which should never happened. This is embarrassing to me as someone from America came here in the Philippines and did something like this,” he said, alluding to Hendricks.

According to him, he got a sick feeling when he

was interviewing nine of the sexual abuse victims of Hendricks, calling them ‘brave’ for speaking out.

“You have to understand that it’s very embarrassing to come forward and say that this thing happened to them and you don’t like the world to know that and you just want to forget about it,” Worley said.

“So it’s really brave for them and say ‘hey, this happened to me and I will say something and do something about it so they will not happen again to somebody else,” he added.

The American lawyer said that the narrations of the victims, who were seven and 12 years old at that time they were reportedly sexually abused by Hendricks, would serve as testimonies that he would use to pin down the disgraced priest.

“It’s basically testimonies as evidence ‘here’s what happened to me, here’s what happened to him’. It’s all testimony,” he said.

He also urged other alleged victims of Hendricks to come out and speak to ensure that their case will be strengthened further.

“I hope that they will come forward. The more witnesses, the more it will help the case and maybe help stop from happening to someone else,” Worley said.

SENIOR POLICE Officer 1 Mary Chris Camacho is a battered wife.

As she starts to consider her own welfare and safety, the 40-year-old police officer decides to leave her husband and singlehandedly raises their two sons.

After defying and surviving the domestic abuses, Camacho never looked back.

“My personal experience pushed me to assert my right as a woman of worth and that only then abuse and violence in the homes will end,” she said.

The police officer used her painful experience as a platform for her women’s rights advocacy when she represented Tacloban City during the recently-concluded Mrs. Philippines Asia 2019 in Manila.

Standing five feet and five inches tall, this feisty yet tender mother and police officer becomes the first married woman of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to join a national beauty pageant.

She brought the crown.

Having won the title of Mrs. Philippines Asia-Pacific Cosmopolitan 2019 on February 3, Camacho now serves as an inspiration to other women to rise above the various abuses in the society.

“Battered wives should never be afraid. We have Republic Act 9262 or Anti-Violence against Women and Children to fight abusive partners. We should pursue this,” Camacho, who entered the police force in 2005, said.

Despite being separated

from her husband, Camacho finds the courage to pursue her role as a parent and police officer in her own way.

Her eldest son graduated in Information Technology while the other is soon to finish his degree in Hotel and Restaurant Management.

Camacho, who hails from Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur, said that women should be aware of their rights.

“We need to inform and disseminate to the people about this law, promoting the welfare of women from all walks of life,” she adds.

Formerly assigned at PNP-Crame based as a liaison officer for four years, Camacho is currently assigned at the logistics division of the Police Regional Office, Camp Ruperto Kangleon in Palo, Leyte.

Police Regional Director Dionardo Carlos said that the men and women in the

regional police force “are one with the world in celebrating the International Women’s Month and International Women’s Day.”

“In this modern age, we respect and support every woman’s rights, aspirations, and battles toward gender equality, empowerment, decision-making and nation-building,” he said.

“Women are the epitome of change. They are the special species created by God as equal of man in all aspects, partners in all worthy endeavors,” the police regional director, as he lauded Camacho for successfully defying the odds.

Women law enforcers in Eastern Visayas are only 1,420 of the over 9,000 police force, but for Camacho, she believes that women are capable to fulfill what they want to achieve in life, may it be in the workplace or at home.

Construction worker arrested inside a lodging inn in a buy-bust operation

TACLOBAN CITY- The anti-drug elements of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA-8) together with the Tacloban City Police Station 2 and its special drug enforcement unit (SDEU) arrested a newly-identified drug personality during a buy-bust operation conducted at the Jerucel Pension House located in Barangay 31, this city, on March 14 at around 9:10 pm.

The suspect was identified as Jethro Villamor, 27,

single, construction worker and a resident of Brgy. 60-A Old Road Sagkahan, this city.

Purchased from the suspect was one piece heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet containing white crystalline substance, a suspected to be shabu worth P500.

Confiscated and recovered from the suspect’s possession were three pieces heat-sealed transparent plastic sachets containing shabu with an estimated total market value

of P1500 placed on an empty box of a cigarette and one piece P500 bill used as a buy-bust money.

The suspect will be facing charges for violation of section 5 (sale of dangerous drugs) and section 11 (possession of dangerous drugs), Article II of RA 9165 and is now temporarily detained at Tacloban City Police Station custodial facility.



If it flows from a clean source, then it must be fit for human consumption such as drinking, cooking, doing the dishes and laundry, and many more. But if it exits from dirty sources, then it could only be utilized for some other uses such as flushing toilet bowls, watering the plants, and washing animal cages.


Use the water inappropriately, and you would have problems later. Take me for example. When I was yet in elementary, I got sick of amoeba because I and my school friends were drinking the water that looked brownish from a deep well. Sanitation was nowhere in our vocabulary then, nor were we health-conscious.

Among the grown-up people around, no one ever stopped us from drinking that water, even just to tell us that that water was not fit for drinking.

Some say we are running out of water, especially now that we are experiencing El Nino that rids many places of rainwater. But this is just the opposite of La Nina, which is plaguing the other parts of the world. With the latter, water is excessively abundant, flooding being the usual extent of its fury. This is rather overwhelming—an oversupply of unnecessary water. Much of this water is wasted here just because it cannot be accommodated anymore for worthwhile utilization.

It’s quite inappropriate to say, then, that the world is running short of water because, as a matter of fact, water level is rising worldwide, implying that water is abundant. But this is not the kind of water that we need; these are dirty waters. What we need is clean water that is fit for human consumption—this is the kind of water that is getting rare nowadays due to the worsening pollution

Government proposed Kaliwa Dam, Anti-Biodiversity

I have opted to talk about the would-be effect to the Biodiversity of the Sierra Madre of the proposed government project to build the Kaliwa Dam. We, members of the PHILTER (Philippine Long term Ecological Research) National Committee, met last January 18th at UP Diliman to tackle the issue on the state of Biodiversity of the country. We talked about the Sierra Madre – one of the most biodiverse areas and the largest remaining tract of rainforest in the country.

The proposed Kaliwa Dam sits on the Sierra Madre mountains, whose forests and coastline are covered by Presidential Proclamation No. 1636, se-

ries of 1977. Sierra Madre is home to 15 rare species of amphibians, 334 bird

species, 1,476 fish species, 963 invertebrates species, 81 mammal species, 50 plant and 60 reptile species. Accordingly, the IUCN (International Union for Conservation of Nature) has reported that from within the PP 1636 protected area, a significant number of species of which are considered as globally threatened. The number will increase should anthropogenic interventions take place (e.g.

And it’s because they were identified to supporting a candidate running against the brother of the outgoing mayor, Editha Cipriano claimed.

According to Cipriano, she and 21 other women from different barangays of the town were among the beneficiaries of a livelihood training program sponsored by the Techni-

cal Education, Skills and Development Authority (TESDA) in coordination with the local government unit of Culaba.

Cipriano, a resident of Barangay Salvacion of said town, claimed that they

were not allowed to use the training center where they could have used the sewing skills that they have learned under the program.

“We were asked by the secretary of the mayor that we cannot use the training center to sew because we are tagged to be supporting another candidate,” she said.

Cipriano said that they are disappointed on this decision of the municipal government using politics as a basis for disallowing them to use the training center.

Vega with its placing as a critical poll area, is high.

“It’s possible that its security force will be augmented,” he said.







E. Visayas PNP seeks P1.35-B budget for choppers

TACLOBAN CITY -- The Philippine National Police (PNP) in Eastern Visayas is proposing at least P1.35 billion budget in 2020 to buy new helicopters to boost its law enforcement operational capability.

PNP Regional Director, Police Brig. Gen. Dionardo Carlos, told the members of the Regional Development Council (RDC) on Friday (March 22) that a helicopter will cost about P450 million each.

"With the kind of terrain that we have in the region, we need Agusta A109 helicopters. During operations, the chopper will serve as a communication link. It will help a lot in saving the lives of our troops as this will be used

during emergency situations," Carlos added during the 2020 budget proposal presentation.

The PNP's air asset will bolster the operational capability of the police in fighting criminality, terrorism, and response to emergencies that require air-ground operations.

Currently, the PNP regional office here, with more than 9,000 personnel in six provinces, has no air asset, Carlos said.

Part of the proposed project is the setting up of air stations at the regional office and some police headquarters in the provinces.

The RDC-Development Administration Committee endorsed the proposal along with P510.88 million

worth of projects of the police regional office lined up for 2020.

Among the priority activities next year include the construction of PNP buildings, new police station buildings, covered courts, motor pools, and sea craft acquisition.

"The proposed projects are implementation ready with architectural designs, programs of work and lot of donations from local government units," Carlos said.

These projects are meant to complement the enhancement of peace-keeping efforts articulated in the regional development plan and strong drive in eradicating illegal drugs. **(SARWELL Q. MENIANO/PNA)**

PCA pushes buko juice consumption to help coco farmers

PALO, Leyte -The Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) in Eastern Visayas is asking government agencies and local governments to promote the consumption of buko (young coconut) juice to raise the income of farmers affected by the steadily declining copra price.

PCA Regional Manager Jeffrey delos Reyes said that if half of the region's more than four million population will drink

buko juice daily, the region's coconut farmers will earn an additional P20 million every day.

Young coconut is bought at PHP10 per piece in farms and marketed by vendors at PHP20 to PHP25 per piece.

"Our call to government officials is to serve coconut water in all our activities instead of soda drinks to support our local coconut industry. Let

us be ambassadors of the coconut sector," delos Reyes told reporters.

PCA pushed for the promotion of young coconut as copra farm gate price plunged to PHP11 per kilogram this week from P21 in the same period last year.

The government has no control on the fluctuating copra price since it is dictated by the global oil market dominated by

City gov't forms team to conduct inspection of business establishments

TACLOBAN CITY – A joint inspection team (JIT) was formed by the city government through the leadership of Mayor Cristina G. Romualdez to ensure the compliance of local business establishments to safety standards and regulations set by local ordinances and national laws.

According to Officer-In-Charge of the Business Permits and License Division (BPLD), Melanie De Leon the 9-member JIT will conduct inspections of local establishments starting on March 25, 2019.

De Leon disclosed that foremost of the team's mandate is to monitor the adherence of local businesses to regulatory requirements mandated by local ordinances and National Laws.

"Disclosure verifications" and tax mapping activities will also be conducted on registered establishments, as well as "identify" unregistered businesses in the city. Violators will be given notice of violations, she added.

The JIT is composed of representatives from the BPLD, Bureau of Fire Protection, City Health Office, City Environment and Natural Resources and City En-

gineer's Office, City Assessor's Office, City Planning and Development Office, City Treasurer's Office and Tacloban City Police Office.

The conduct of the comprehensive mapping of all businesses of the city by the JIT will help in the upscaling of the business permits and licensing systems in Tacloban.

It will also ensure responsiveness to the public and equalize access to frontline services and facilities significantly in securing business permits and licenses.

palm oil and soybean oil with a share of 35 percent and 26 percent, respectively.

The copra price drop has been affecting 367,234 coconut farmers in the Eastern Visayas region. It is estimated that 1.83 million people or nearly half of the region's 4.4 million population are dependent on coconut.

Copra is the dried meat or kernel of the coconut wherein premium oil is extracted. It also yields coconut cake after oil extraction, which is mainly used as feeds for livestock.

"Since coconut is considered as a tree of

life, we want to send a message to our farmers that there is more money from coconut other than copra production," delos Reyes said.

The official urged local government units to help organize coconut farmers and facilitate the trading of their products in commercial centers.

In the National Capital Region, the Metro Manila Development Authority committed to support the initiative of the Department of Agriculture to market fresh young coconuts using multi-cabs or small trucks in populated areas where the demand for coconut water is high.

Coconut water known as buko juice is the liquid endosperm

obtained from a young coconut which is pure and nutritious natural beverage. The sterile water, which is approximately 200 – 750 ml, is enclosed with a hard shell and a well-lined layer of coconut meat.

The natural drink is high in ionic nutrients (electrolytes) such as potassium, sodium, calcium, magnesium, chloride, phosphorus and sulfur. It also contains sugar, in the form of glucose and fructose, Vitamin C, Vitamin B group and amino acids such as glutamic acid, arginine, aspartic acid, and leucine.

Among the benefits of buko juice are lowered risk of heart attacks, increase metabolic rate, help in dissolving
